I thank you so much for your kindness at that time.

But I have one thing to ask your help: in our APC-tank, there was a soldier with us who very kindly nursed the wounded V.C. boy in the tank (see the picture here enveloped). Would you kindly let me know this soldiers full name, rank, and home adress in U.S.A.?

I would like to send my article to his home after of publication; and, to send it your home also, please write me your home adress too. Hope see your again somewhere, and good luck to you.
